



# NARRATE

Building a narrative approach fostering collaboration between preschools and libraries



## About the project

NARRATE is a three-year project funded by the Erasmus+ programme.

The general objective is to foster quality in preschool education through increased attention to the narrative approach.



## Specific Objectives

1. Developing the narrative approach in preschools, adopting the appropriate tools to arrange the context, planning activities and evaluating the outcomes.
2. Improving the collaboration between preschools and libraries for enhancing the narrative curriculum and giving value and visibility to the spontaneous narrative production of the children;
3. Increasing preschool teachers' professional skills on the narrative approach/curriculum.

## 3 Intellectual Outputs

### 1 Handbook



A handbook on the implementation of the narrative curriculum in preschools: guidelines on arranging the learning settings and the educational plan.

### 2 Evaluation toolbox



Self-Assessment, Monitoring, Impact Assessment (SAMIA)  
A set of tools for monitoring evaluation both for the appropriateness of the school setting and for the children's learning well-being in the preschools adopting the narrative approach.

### 3 Original childhood literature



At least 8 original childhood literature products starting from the children's spontaneous narrative creativity.
